

FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS

As a first-year university student, you will be allocated a recently renovated Premium Single Room. While having the privacy of your own room is excellent, you will quickly discover that our communal facilities play a big part in helping you meet your peers and develop new friendships. You will also be required to have 21 meals per week in our communal Dining Hall.

Once you progress to your second year of study, you can apply to reside in one of our Standard Studio Rooms with a minimum of seven meals per week in our Dining Hall.
